Menai Straits

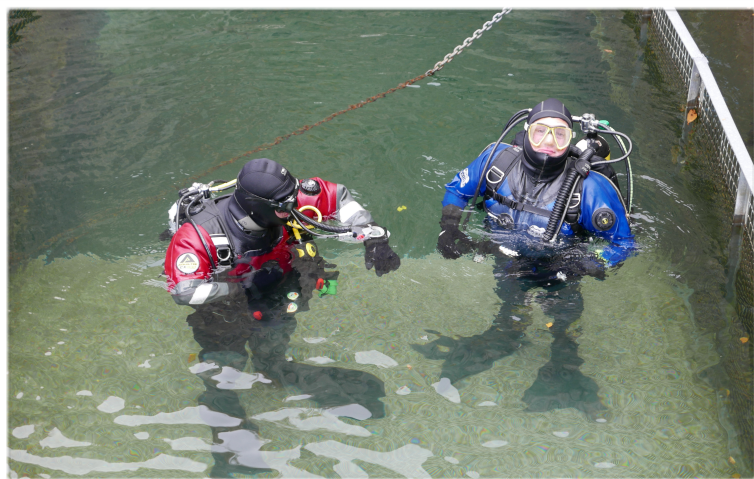
